ADMISSION PROCESS

The minimum age for Admission in Montessori-I is 2 years 6 months as on 1st April of the year of Admission. As a proof of age birth certificate from the Municipality must be submitted. Registrations for Classes Montessori-I, II & III starts in the month of November. Admission to Grade I to IX depends upon the efficiency of the child during the entrance test. Every candidate who is registered is given the date and time for the entrance test. Admission to all the classes closes by 30th April. In the interest of pupil's attendance, parents are advised to complete all admission /readmission formalities by the end of April every year.

Mere Registration is no Guarantee for Admission

At the time of admission (for Classes I to IX) along with application form, a photocopy of the original Birth Certificate, photocopy of Aadhar Card, Original Transfer Certificate from the school last attended, counter signed by the Block Education Officer (BEO) and the most recent (original) report card is to be submitted along with coloured 4 passport size photos. Apart from the various prescribed fees payable during an academic year, parents should pay annual charges at the beginning of every academic year.

Admission to Class XI depends upon the CBSE or equivalent Board Results. At the time of admission a photocopy of Aadhar Card, Original Transfer Certificate from the school last attended, Migration if from other board, a photocopy of recent Marksheet is to be submitted alongwith coloured 4 passport size photos.

Withdrawal: Parents/ Guardians are not allowed to withdraw their ward in the middle of the session. If situation arises they have to pay full session fee.

SCHOOL CURRICULUM

Montessori (I to III)

Montessori standards introduced into the schools take children from two and half years of age after pre schooling of CDC until they attain five and half years of age. During this period, they cover three classes from Montessori I to III. Play way method is used for teaching children of this category.

Forty percent stress is laid on academic management and sixty percent of the total curriculum is earmarked for different activities to generate learning excitement in beginners.

Primary Level (Std. I to V)

During the primary level of education, children have to use more of their brain and get an environment to communicate in English. Academic and non-academic activities in this section go at equal proportions.

Middle Level (Std. VI to VIII)

Besides reading, writing, pronunciation, and vocabulary, proper care is taken to make the children learn behaviour, manners etiquette, and discipline. Seventy percent stress is laid on academic curriculum, whereas thirty percent emphasis is given to different other activities.

Secondary School Level (Std. IX to X)

With reduction in activities as far as possible, adequate care is taken for building up good academic career without neglecting the course of physical education. Linguistic development with particular reference to English is planned by adopting various devices like orientation in grammar, vocabulary, usages, and composition. Hundred percent attention is focused on Academic Curriculum, to ensure the students' success.

Senior Secondary Level (Std. XI to XII)

Students during this period are made to be equipped with self-confidence, so that they can choose a good befitting career for themselves and bring credit not only to themselves but also to the school, to their families and to the nation as a whole. Discipline is emphasised from the very beginning and mock intervals to develop the same.





Parent-Teacher Interactions

The Group keeps a provision of PTM (Parent-Teacher Meeting) at Inter calls to discuss and identify psychological, academic related problems of individual students and find out solution to them. Helpline system has been evolved to strengthen such interactions.

THE BOARDING FACILITY

"Home Away From Home"

The School takes pride in closely monitoring the educational and emotional well being of each and every student. The School takes such good care of the children that the word home sickness ceases to exist in their vocabularies. The School has separate well-furnished Blocks for Boys & Girls. They are aesthetically designed with optimum convenience. The rooms in Hostel are strategically located to ensure that the children have easy access to the dining hall and classrooms. The Hostel Supervisor monitors the daily activities of the students.

TO PARENTS OF ALL BOARDERS

- 1. A List of articles should be pasted on the inside lid of the trunk and a duplicate copy must be handed over to the Matron.
- 2. The School cannot arrange for the safe keeping of any valuables, therefore it is forbidden to the students to carry any valuable items/money or any electronic gadgets. If found, will be confiscated and a fine shall be charged.
- 3. For any medical issues, prior information should be provided to the Supervisor.
- 4. You will be allowed to meet your ward only on Sundays from 1p.m to 5p.m. and in case of emergencies, prior permission from the Principal is mandate.
- 5. Do not visit the campus after 5p.m. either to pick or drop your child or even to meet.
- 6. You will not be allowed to enter the hostel building without permission.
- 7. The child must have 75% attendance and all dues clear to sit for any of the Examinations.
- 8. All the Dues must be cleared on time.
- 9. Do apply for leave beforehand if you want to take your ward to home or out of the campus.
- 10. You must not make any call after 10 p.m. You will be allowed to talk with your ward on Saturdays & Sundays only. (Saturday: 4pm-9pm); (Sunday: 2pm-6pm).
- 11. Please make sure that your child has his/her hostel uniform and Bed sheet provided by the School with him/her whenever he/she is entering the premises.
- 12. Only 3 sets of Casual will be allowed to be kept in the Hostel and no other Bed Sheets.
- 13. Please make sure that your child reports on the very first day the School reopens after Holidays or Vacation, otherwise a fine of Rs. 10/-everyday will be charged against his absence.
- 14. Only Mother/Father is allowed to make a call on Hostel's Number. No other calls will be entertained.
- 15. No Parents will be allowed to be in the hostel rooms for more than 15 minutes.
- 16. Please do not give your mobile phones to other children in the Hostel. This breaks our discipline.
- 17. Accommodation in the hostel cannot be claimed as a right. The school authority reserves all the rights to change the dorm/locker/bed etc of the students.
- 18. Any breakage/damage of the School property shall be recovered from the parents during the academic session.
- 19. There are three 'Term Holidays' during the academic year, i.e. May-June (Summer Vacation), September/October (Puja Vacation) and March-April (Term end). It is obligatory for the parents to take their ward home during the Term Holidays.
- 20. Parents/ Guardians are not allowed to withdraw their ward in the middle of the session. If situation arises they have to pay full session fee.
